ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Derbyshire County Council (Lower Hardwick Street, Buxton) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1986.

Notice is hereby given that the Derbyshire County Council propose to make an Order, under sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3) and 4 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers.

When this Order comes into effect you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle in the following lengths of road at Buxton.

Waiting prohibited at any time

Lower Hardwick Street, on the north side, from its junction with Terrace Road to its junction with Hardwick Street, on the south side from its junction with Hardwick Street for a distance of 9 metres and from a point 27 metres from its junction with Hardwick Street westwards for a distance of 20 metres and a point 61 metres west of its junction with Hardwick Street to its junction with Terrace Road.

Waiting limited between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. to 40 minutes with a prohibition on return within 1 hour

Lower Hardwick Street, on the south side, from a point 9 metres from its junction with Hardwick Street westwards for a distance of 18 metres and from a point 47 metres from its junction with Hardwick Street westwards for a distance of 14 metres.

NOTE. It will be necessary to revoke the Derbyshire County Council (Traffic Regulation) (Buxton) Order 1976 in so far as it relates in Schedule 1 to Lower Hardwick Street.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order to enable vehicles to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle; to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic; the maintenance of the roads or the services therein to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated within the lengths of road; or as part of a funeral or wedding cortege. The usual exemptions for disabled persons' vehicles will be provided in the Order.

Full details of the proposal are in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the prohibited areas and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at Room 108, County Offices, Matlock, (Mrs. J. Senior), during normal office hours 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday to Friday, and at the offices of the Director of Planning, Buxton Town Hall, Market Place, Buxton.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to the undersigned by Monday 21st July 1986.

DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Derbyshire County Council (Torr Top Street, New Mills) (Traffic Management) Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that the Derbyshire County Council propose to make an Order, under sections 1, (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3) and 4 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers.

When this Order comes into effect:

(a) You will not be allowed to load your vehicle in the following lengths of road at New Mills.

No loading or unloading

Torr Top Street, on both sides from a point 22 metres from its junction with Market Street for a distance of 36 metres (along the frontage of the Co-operative Store).
