

- (2) Any vehicle proceeding in a southerly direction along the road specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 to this notice from making a left hand turn into the road specified in column 2 of Schedule 2.

The Order came into operation on 18th June 1986 and a copy thereof and a map showing the road to which the Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Mid Glamorgan County Council, Cathays Park, Cardiff, during normal office hours until the end of 6 weeks from 18th June 1986.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks from 18th June 1986, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE 1

Revocation of Orders

- (i) Clearway Order: No stopping 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. except for buses.

New Road, north side, from a point 30 metres from the eastern kerb-line of Picton Road for a distance of 35 metres approximately in an easterly direction.

- (ii) 1 hour limited waiting Monday to Saturday 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

New Road, north side, from a point 92 metres from the eastern kerb-line of Picton Road for a distance of 18 metres approximately in an easterly direction.

- (iii) No waiting Monday to Saturday 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

from the western kerb-line of High Street for a distance of 20 metres in a westerly direction.

- (c) Christopher Road, both sides, from the southern kerb-line of New Road for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction.

- (ii) 1 hour limited waiting Monday to Saturday 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

- (a) New Road, north side:

from a point 5 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Station Road to a point 5 metres west of the western kerb-line of Grove Road;

from a point 5 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Grove Road to a point 5 metres west of the western kerb-line of Picton Road;

from a point 60 metres from the eastern kerb-line of Picton Road for a distance of 30 metres in an easterly direction.

- (b) New Road, south side, from a point 20 metres west of the western kerb-line of High Street for a distance of 15 metres in a westerly direction.

- (c) Bethlehem Road, north-east side, from a point 15 metres south-east of the southern kerb-line of New Road for a distance of 60 metres in a south-westerly direction.
