PENWITH COUNTY COUNCIL

Penwith District Council (Off-Street Parking Places Increase of Charges) Order 1986

The District Council of Penwith ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 35(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of Part 4, Schedule 9 to the Acts of all other enabling powers and with the consent of the County Council of Cornwall in accordance with section 39(3) of the Act and after consulting Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part 3 of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st June 1986 and may be cited as the Penwith District Council (Off-Street Parking Places Increase of Charges) Order 1986.
2. This Order is supplemental to the Penwith District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1985, ("the Order").
3. The charging period and the charges set out in the schedule to the Penwith District Council (Off-Street Parking Places Increase of Charges) Order 1986 shall be substituted for the charging period and the charges set out in the Schedule to the 1985 Order and except as varied therein the Order of 1985 shall remain in full force and effect.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained therein on the grounds it is not within the powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 upon the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks from the date of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

BASILDON DISTRICT COUNCIL

The District of Basildon (Road 96 and Station Way, Basildon) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that the District Council of Basildon pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 and in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 made on 27th May 1986 a traffic order the effect of which is:

To impose a prohibition of waiting at any time:

- (a) on Road 96 for its entire length
- (b) on Road 96 car park its access
- (c) on Station Way from its junction with Southernhay to its junction with Road 96.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan relating to the Order may be examined at this office between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Mondays to Fridays.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it have not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 27th May 1986, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Please note that any written views you submit on this issue will, with certain exceptions, be included in the papers which will be available for inspection by the general public who will have the right to obtain a copy.

This Order will come into operation on 2nd June 1986.

SOUTHEND-ON-SEA BOROUGH COUNCIL

Southend-on-Sea Borough Council (Woodgrange Drive) Prohibition of Waiting Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Southend-on-Sea made an Order on 23rd May 1986 pursuant to arrangements under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Essex in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting in parts of Huntingdon Road, Lifstan Way, Marlborough Road, Rutland Avenue, Sandringham Road and Woodgrange Drive.

Exceptions in the Order permit waiting for the following purposes:

- (a) Picking up or setting down passengers.
- (b) Loading or unloading goods.
- (c) Carrying out essential services connected with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water and electricity.
- (d) By disabled persons vehicles complying with the conditions set out in the Order.

The Order will come into effect on 2nd June 1986.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from 23rd May 1986 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SOUTHEND-ON-SEA BOROUGH COUNCIL

Southend-on-Sea Borough Council (Carlingford Drive) Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Southend-on-Sea made an Order on 23rd May 1986 pursuant to arrangements under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Essex in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act the effect of which will be as follows:

to prohibit and restrict waiting in lengths of Carlingford Drive, Cardigan Avenue, Commercial Road and Hillborough Road as set out in the Order.

Exceptions in the Order permit waiting for the following purposes:

- (a) Picking up or setting down passengers.
- (b) Loading or unloading goods.
- (c) Carrying out essential services connected with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water and electricity.
- (d) By disabled persons vehicles complying with the conditions set out in the Order.

The Order will come into effect on 2nd June 1986.
