BARNET LONDON BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Barnet (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Amendment No.) Order 198

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet propose to make an Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other enabling powers.

The general effect of the Order will be further to amend the Barnet (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1978 so that:

- (a) the waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivery or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the lengths of Totteridge Lane specified in Schedule 1;
- (b) in the lengths of Totteridge Lane specified in the Schedule 2 to this notice, the hours during which the existing prohibition applies on waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be changed so that such prohibition would apply between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;

(c) the waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place would be prohibited between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the lengths of Totteridge Lane specified in Schedules 1 and 2 to this Notice;

BERKSHIRE ROYAL COUNTY COUNCIL

Royal County of Berkshire (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (Restriction of Roads) (Various Roads, Lower Earley) (No.) Order 1986.
