

## CLWYD COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County Council of Clwyd (Morley Road and Thorpe Street, Rhyl) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1986*

Notice is hereby given that the Clwyd County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3) and 4 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles:

- (a) at any time in the lengths of road or on the sides of lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- (b) between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on the sides of lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

Exceptions will be provided in the proposed Order to permit waiting for the purposes of alighting, boarding, loading, unloading and works of maintenance, repair and the like.

Exceptions will also be provided in the proposed Order to allow vehicles displaying both a disabled person's badge and a disabled person's parking disc to wait in the lengths of road or on the sides of lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this notice for a period not exceeding 2 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same day).

A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the lengths of road and sides of lengths of road to which the proposed Order relates and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the Shire Hall, Mold, during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposed Order, together with the grounds on which they are made, should be sent in writing to the undersigned by 30th June 1986.

## SCHEDULE 1

*Lengths of road and sides of lengths of road in Rhyl in the Borough of Rhuddlan in the County of Clwyd*

*Thorpe Street*, both sides:

- (a) from its junction with B5119 Brighton Road for a distance of 5 metres in a south-easterly direction;
- (b) from a point 42 metres south-east of its junction with B5119 Brighton Road to its junction with Morley Road.

*Morley Road*

North-westerly side, from a point 44 metres south-west of the south-westerly kerb-line of Bath Street to its junction with Thorpe Street.

South-easterly side, from a point 53 metres south-west of its junction with Bath Street to its junction with Thorpe Street.

## SCHEDULE 2

*Thorpe Street*, north-easterly side, from a point 5 metres south-east of its junction with B5119 Brighton Road for a distance of 37 metres in a south-easterly direction.

*Morley Road*, north-westerly side, from a point 10 metres south-west of the south-westerly kerb-line of Bath Street for a distance of 34 metres in a south-westerly direction.

*The County Council of Clwyd (Brymbo Link Road) (De-restriction) (No. 3) Order 1986*

Notice is hereby given that on 27th May 1986 the Clwyd County Council with the consent of the Secretary of State for Wales made the above-named Order under sections 82 (2) and 83 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is that the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice are de-restricted and are therefore not subject to a speed limit other than the national limit.

A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 2nd June 1986, and a map showing the lengths of road to which the Order relates may be examined at the Shire Hall, Mold, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 27th May 1986 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

## SCHEDULE 1

*Lengths of road in the Borough of Wrexham Maelor in the County of Clwyd*

1. That length of the Brymbo Link Road which extends from a point approximately 180 metres north-west of its junction with Park Road, Tanyfron for a distance of approximately 980 metres in a south-easterly direction.

2. The whole length of the loop link road which extends from its junction with the Brymbo Link Road to its junction with the B5101 near the property known as Toll-gate House, a distance of approximately 130 metres.

3. That the length of the B5101 which extends from a point approximately 50 metres north of its junction with the loop link road described in 2 above for a distance of approximately 140 metres in a southerly direction.

4. That length of the Brymbo Link Road which extends from its junction with the A525 for a distance of approximately 140 metres in a northerly direction.

5. That length of the A525 which extends from a point approximately 120 metres north-west of its junction with the Brymbo Link Road for a distance of approximately 660 metres in a south-easterly direction.

6. Those lengths of both slip roads leading from the A525 to the A483 which extends from their junctions with the A525 for a distance of approximately 90 metres in north-easterly and south-westerly directions, as the case may be.

7. Those lengths of both slip roads leading from the A483 to the A525 which extends from their junctions with the A525 for a distance of approximately 76 metres in north-easterly and south-westerly directions, as the case may be.
