The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Ham Street, Orlestone) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that the Kent County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1, 2 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which would be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at all times in The Street, A2070, Ham Street as follows:

- (a) on the east side from 63 metres south of Ruckinge Road for 88 metres southwards; and
- (b) on the west side, from 82 metres south of Warehorne Road for 140 metres southwards.

Exceptions would be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait with police permission or for passengers to board or alight, for the loading or unloading of goods, for enabling work to be carried out in or adjacent to the road, for disabled persons and for emergency service vehicles.
