

SCHEDULE 4

1 hour Limited Waiting

Lengths and sides of lengths of road in the Walsall Metropolitan Borough

- Bath Street*, west and north sides, from a point 5 metres south of its junction with Walsall Street in a southerly and westerly direction for a distance of 55 metres.
- Cheapside*, west side, from a point 10 metres north of its junction with New Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 65 metres.
- Clemson Street*, both sides, from a point 10 metres east of its junction with Upper Lichfield Street at its junction with Middle Gardens.
- John Street*, north side, from a point 5 metres east of its junction with Upper Lichfield Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 115 metres.
- Leve Lane*, west side, from a point 25 metres north of its junction with John Street in a northerly direction to its junction with Lower Lichfield Street.

Lower Lichfield Street

South side, from a point 15 metres east of its junction with Upper Lichfield Street in an easterly direction to its junction with Leve Lane.

North side:

from its junction with Wood Street in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 90 metres;  
from a point 20 metres south-west of its junction with Union Street in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 95 metres.

*Moat Street*, south side, from a point 25 metres east of its junction with Stafford Street to a point 20 metres west of its junction with Gower Street.

*Wolverhampton Street*, north and north-west sides, from its junction with Gomer Street for a distance of 218 metres in a westerly and then south-westerly direction.

SCHEDULE 5

At Any Time

Lengths and sides of lengths of road in the Walsall Metropolitan Borough

*Bow Street*

North-west side, from its junction with Walsall Street for a distance of 59 metres in a south-westerly direction.

South-east side, from its junction with Walsall Street for a distance of 73 metres in a south-westerly direction.

*Lower Lichfield Street*, north side, from its junction with Upper Lichfield Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 150 metres.

*Stafford Street*, east side, from its junction with Little Wood Street to its junction with Moat Street.

*Wolverhampton Street*

North-west side, from its junction with Pinson Road for a distance of 20 metres in a north-easterly direction.

South-east side, from its junction with New Road for a distance of 17 metres in a north-easterly direction.
