The District of Waveney (Off-street) Parking Places Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that Waveney District Council has made an Order under section 35 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to control the use of the parking places named in the Schedule to this notice, which shows the class of vehicles, the days and times of operation, the maximum period for waiting and the scales of charges for each parking place. The Order specifies the conditions under which the parking places may be used. Where charges are made, the Order increases the charges payable on the parking places.

The Order was made on 22nd May 1986 and will come into effect on 23rd May 1986.
