Notice is hereby given that on 17th July 1986 Hartlepool Borough Council (pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Council of the County of Cleveland in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers) made the above-named Order the effect of which is to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than Sunday on the north side of Elwick Road from its junction with Wansbeck Gardens in an easterly direction to its junction with Caroline Street.

Exemptions will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, the maintenance of roads, the supply of gas, electricity and water and for disabled persons.

A copy of the Order which will come into operation on 4th August 1986 and of a map showing the road concerned may be inspected between 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. Monday to Friday at the Civic Centre, Victoria Road, Hartlepool.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from the date of publication hereof apply to the High Court for this purpose.
