The current authorised combined rates of abstraction are 9 million litres per day and 2,667 million litres per year for public water supply sources.

The proposals are to combine the two licences into one new licence and abstract water from:

- (2) the Yarde Lane boreholes at national grid reference ST 905 085, at a maximum rate of 1.5 million litres per day, 138 million litres per year for discharge into Pimperne Stream during the period 1st June to 31st August in each year.
