PETROLEUM AND SUBMARINE PIPE-LINES ACT 1975

Notice of the Issue of a Submarine Pipe-line Works Authorisation

The Secretary of State for Energy hereby gives notice that he has decided to issue, and in consequence has issued, a works authorisation to Phillips Petroleum Company United Kingdom Limited, for the construction and use of a gas flowline and service jumper line between Hewett Well 48/30-K and tie in at Well 48/30-8.

THE PETROLEUM (PRODUCTION) (LANDWARD AREAS) REGULATIONS 1984 (SI 1984 No. 1832)

The Secretary of State for Energy hereby gives notice that the arrangements for the grant of further landward petroleum exploration licences under the above Regulations will be as follows. Applications will be considered against the background of the continuing need to identify and develop landward oil and gas resources in the most expeditious, efficient and thorough manner and where applicants hold or have licences their overall record will be taken into account. Arrangements for applications for appraisal and development licences are set out in the Gazette Notice published 2nd July 1985.

Applications for exploration licences

The Secretary of State is prepared to receive applications for exploration licences in respect of areas covered by exploration licences prior to the commencement of the above Regulations ("existing exploration licences") provided the applicant is the existing licensee or is a member of a consortium which includes at least one of the existing licensees. (In these arrangements applications will not be considered for licences covering contiguous unlicensed areas and the existing exploration licence must be extant at the date of application).

Applications shall be by reference to one or more contiguous blocks as shown on the Inspection Map at the Department of Energy, Room 1349, Thames House South, Millbank, London SW1P 4QJ. Applicants will be expected to have completed sufficiently detailed seismic surveys to identify potential drillable prospects.
