

- Road about 260 metres south-east of its junction with Giggan Street (U/C 9024) shall become a trunk road as from the date when the Order comes into operation ;
- (2) an Order under sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980 providing that a length of the Trunk Road starting at a point about 200 metres north-west of its junction with Station Road (C271) and going generally south-eastwards for 2.05 kilometres to a point about 340 metres south-east of its junction with Giggan Street (U/C 9024) all in the said district and county shall cease to be a Trunk Road as from the date on which notice is given by him to the Wiltshire County Council (who will become the highway authority responsible for that length) that the new trunk road is open for through traffic ; and,
- (3) an Order under sections 12, 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising him :

- (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways.
- (b) to stop-up highways,
- (c) to construct new highways,
- (d) to stop up private means of access to premises ; and
- (e) to provide new means of access to premises

all at Codford aforesaid,

and providing for the transfer of the said new highways to the County Council of Wiltshire as from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies the Council that the

new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.

Copies of the draft Orders and relevant plans may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 5th September 1986 until 5th December 1986 or within 3 months from the date of publication of this notice, which ever period shall expire later, at the Department of Transport, 2 Marsham Street, London S.W.1, and at the offices of the Director (Transport) South West Region, Tollgate House, Houlton Street, Bristol BS2 9DJ, and of the Wiltshire County Council, County Hall, Trowbridge, Wiltshire, Warminster Public Library, New Library Building, Three Horseshoes Mall, Warminster, Wiltshire and the Post Office, 73-74 High Street, Codford, Warminster BA12 0ND.

Any person may, not later than 5th December 1986 or within 3 months from the date of publication of this notice, if such period shall expire later, object to the making of the Orders, by notice to the Secretary of State at his address at the office of the Director (Transport) South West Region, Room 423, Tollgate House, Houlton Street, Bristol, quoting ref. DSW 507909/TR39/05/1, and stating the grounds of objection. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of grounds of objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.
