#### NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

#### NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Southern Water Authority by the Central Electricity Generating Board, South Eastern Region, Bankside House, Sumner Street, London SE1 9JU, for a licence to abstract the following quantities of water from the lagoons to the east of the access road to Dungeness 'B' Power Station, Kent, at the following point of abstraction: 1,400,000 gallons during the period October 1986 to December 1987, on two occasions, each of approximately 2 days at map reference 0838 1815 on the map accompanying the application.
