NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980*Part of Public Footpath No. 3 Lutton Public Path Diver-  
sion Order 1984*

Notice is hereby given that on 20th November 1986 the Secretary of State for the Environment confirmed the above-named Order with modifications.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the under-mentioned right of way:

In the Parish of Lutton that part of public footpath No. 3 running from Colly's Gate at the northern corner of O.S. Field No. 4900, south-east along the northern boundary of that field for approximately 204 metres to an alternative route running from Colly's Gate at a point on the western boundary of O.S. Field No. 6200 along the west bank of the drain running southwards in that field, then turning to run south-west across the drain and south east across O.S. Field No. 6200 then south-south-west to meet the existing path.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge during normal office hours at County Offices, Newland, Lincoln, and at the offices of the South Holland District Council, Priory Road, Spalding, or purchased at a cost of £1 from the undersigned.

The Order becomes operative as from 19th December 1986, but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order he may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 9th December 1986 make an application for the purpose in the High Court.
