Notice is hereby given that Lewisham Borough Council propose to make the above-mentioned Order under Section 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by Section 8 and Part I of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985. This notice supersedes the notice that appeared in the *London Gazette* and the *Lewisham Mercury* on 27th November 1986 in connection with the (Lewisham Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No.) Traffic Order 198 (Bromley Road/Brookdale Road).
