RATES OF INTEREST ON LOANS BY THE PUBLIC WORKS LOAN COMMISSIONERS TO LOCAL AUTHORITIES

NOTICE

TREASURY MINUTE dated 24th December 1986.

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury read section 3(2) of the National Loans Act 1968 (1968 C.13 as amended) whereby any sums borrowed from the Public Works Loan Commissioners shall bear interest at such rates as the Treasury may determine from time to time in accordance with section 5 of the said Act.

My Lords understand that the Public Works Loan Commissioners will be operating arrangements under which local authorities are permitted to borrow from the Commissioners up to a specified quota at a certain fixed rate of interest and in excess of such quota at one of two higher fixed rates.

In accordance therewith the Chancellor of the Exchequer now recommends that with effect from 24th December 1986 and until the coming into operation of a further determination:

- (i) The rate of interest applicable to any such fixed rate loan will be that in force on the day the authority applies to borrow or, if the application is before noon three working days before the loan is credited to the account of the authority's banker, the rate in force at 11 a.m. two banking days before credit day;
- (ii) Different rates of interest shall be charged on such fixed rate loans according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments, whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.I.P.), or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);

The amount which a local authority borrows within its annual quota will bear interest at the appropriate rate in the quota set of rates. Authorities may borrow further sums at quota rates at the discretion of the Public Works Loan Commissioners. Other borrowing beyond the quota entitlement will be at the appropriate rate in the non-quota set of rates.

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Dorset (Traffic Management, Various Streets, Sherborne) (Experimental) Order 198

Notice is hereby given that the Dorset County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1, 2 and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will be operational on an experimental basis only for an initial period of 6 months and its effects will be as follows:

- (a) Prohibit all vehicles between 11 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday to Saturday on the following lengths of road in Sherborne:
 - (i) Cheap Street, between its junctions with Newland and Long Street;
 - (ii) Abbey Road, between its junctions with Hospital Lane and Cheap Street;
 - (iii) Hound Street, between its junctions with Cheap Street and the southern entrance to Old Market Car Park;

- (b) Prohibit all vehicles from proceeding along Newland, Sherborne between its junctions with Cheap Street and the northerly entrance to Old Market Car Park other than in an easterly direction.

- (c) Prohibit waiting at any time on the following lengths of road in Sherborne:

- (i) Cornhill, on both sides between its junctions with Kitts Hill (A30) and Acreman Street;

- (ii) Acreman Street, on its western side between points 149 metres and 229 metres north of its junction with Trendle Street (The existing no waiting restriction between 9.30 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday on the west side of Acreman Street from a point 149 metres north of its junction with Trendle Street northwards for a distance of 40 metres will be revoked;

- (iii) Acreman Street, on its eastern side between points 189 metres and 229 metres and points 270 metres and 300 metres north of its junction with Trendle Street.

- (d) Prohibit waiting between 9.30 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday on the following lengths of road in Sherborne:
