*The City of Winchester (Central Area)**Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) (Variation No. 1) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that Winchester City Council in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers propose to make an Order the effect of which will be:

(1) To prohibit right turns by all classes of vehicles from Andover Road into Stockbridge Road and Station Hill.

(2) To permit traffic to proceed in either direction in Station Hill from its junction with Gladstone Street to its junction with Station Hill.

(3) To permit traffic to proceed in either direction in Station Hill from a point 99 metres north-west of its junction with Sussex Street to its junction with Station Road.

(4) with the exception of Public Service Vehicles and licensed HACKney Carriages proceeding in a North Westwardly direction to prohibit all vehicles using the length of Station Hill from its junction with Sussex Street to a point 99 metres north west.
