GREENWICH LONDON BOROUGH COUNCIL

London Borough of Greenwich Disabled Persons' Parking Places

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Greenwich, hereinafter called the Council, propose to make the Greenwich (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) Order 198 under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.

The general effect of the Order would be to:

- (a) designate in the Schedule to this Order various parking places in which vehicles authorised by the the Order may be left for any period during the permitted hours without charge;
- (b) provide that each parking place would operate at any time (Christmas Day, Good Friday and bank holidays excepted);
- (c) specify, in respect of each parking place, that disabled persons' vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled person's badge (commonly referred to as "the orange badge") issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982 may be left therein; and
- (d) provide that certain vehicles may wait in each parking place in certain circumstances, e.g., to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc.

A copy of the proposed Order and the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the expiration of a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published, at the Information and Consumer Advice Centre, 43 Wellington Street, Woolwich, London SE18 6PW.

Persons desiring to object to the proposed Order should send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Director of Architectural and Engineering Services, Peggy Middleton House, 50 Woolwich New Road, Woolwich, London SE18 6HQ, within the afore-mentioned period of 21 days.

Persons objecting to the proposed Order should be aware that in view of the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985, this Council would be legally obliged to make any comments received in response to this notice, open to public inspection.
