# UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE

A Statute made by the Governing Body of Magdalen College, in the University of Oxford on 4th March 1987, amending Statutes III, IV and XV has been submitted for the approval of Her Majesty in Council, and notice of its submission is published in accordance with the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act

This Statute reduces the retirement age of College Officers and Official Fellows from sixty-seven to sixty-five years, except for those in post on 1st July 1985.

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 27 (2A) of the Value Added Tax Act 1983 (1983 c55), as inserted by section 11 of the Finance Act 1984 (1984 c.43), hereby direct as follows:

(1) This direction shall come into operation on 1st April 1987.

(2) In this direction:

"the direction" means the Treasury direction given under section 27 (2A) of the Value Added Tax Act 1983, dated 7th November 1984; "the Schedules" mean the Schedules to the direction; and "column (1)" and "column (2)" respectively mean column (1) and column (2) of the Schedules.
