TENDERS FOR TREASURY BILLS

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Securities Office, Bank of England, Threadneedle Street, on Friday 10th April 1987 at 1 p.m. for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act 1877 and the National Loans Act 1968, to the amount of £100,000,000.

2. The Bills will be in amounts of £5,000, £10,000, £25,000, £50,000, £100,000, £250,000 or £1,000,000. They will be dated at the option of the Tenderer on any business day from Monday, 13th April 1987 to Friday 16th April 1987, inclusive, and will be due 91 days after date.

3. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of England.

4. Each Tender must be for an amount not less than £50,000 and must specify the date on which the Bills required are to be dated and the net amount per cent. (being a multiple of half of one penny) which will be given for the amount applied for. Separate Tenders must be lodged for Bills of different dates.

5. Notification will be sent on the day of the Tender to the persons whose Tenders are accepted in whole or in part. Payment in full of the amount due in respect of an accepted Tender must be made to the Bank of England by means of cash, banker's draft payable through the Town Clearing or by cheque drawn on the Bank of England, not later than 1.30 p.m. on the day on which the relative Bills are to be dated and on which they are to be collected from the Securities Office.

6. Tenders must be made on the printed forms which may be obtained from the Bank of England.

7. The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury reserve the right to reject any Tenders. (12 SI)

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made under sections 10, 12, 14, 41, 125 and 326 of the Highways Act 1980, Orders the effect of which is as regards:

- (a) the Swansea-Manchester Trunk Road (Newbridge, Ruabon and Johnstown By-Pass and Slip Roads) Order 1982 (S.I. 1982/941) to enable him to substitute new provisions for some of the provisions of Schedule 1 to that Order;
- (b) the Swansea-Manchester Trunk Road (Newbridge, Ruabon and Johnstown By-Pass and Slip Roads, Side Roads) Order 1982 to enable him to modify the provisions in that Order by substituting respectively for the Schedule and Site Plan numbered 3 (Low Barracks Road and Other Alterations), the Schedule and Site Plan numbered 4 (A5 Whitehurst Link Road), and the Schedule and Site Plan numbered 5 (Alterations to tracks in Wynnstay Estate), to the 1982 Order the similarly numbered and entitled Schedules and Site Plans of the Swansea-Manchester Trunk Road (Newbridge, Ruabon and Johnstown By-Pass and Slip Roads, Side Roads) Order 1982 (Variation) Order 1987.
