*The Trunk Road (A479) (Various Roads, Talgarth, Powys)  
(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that on 1st April 1987, the Secretary of State made the above Order which will come into operation on 29th April 1987.

The effect of the Order is as stated in Notice 1 SI in the London Gazette No. 50796 dated 8th January 1987.

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds:

- (a) that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or
  - (b) that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of that Act,
- he may, within 6 weeks of 1st April 1987, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

ACQUISITION OF LAND ACT 1981

Notice is hereby given that the Public Local Inquiries in connection with the Orders mentioned below will be held by Brigadier J. D. Lofts, M.B.E. (a person appointed for the purpose by the Secretaries

of State for the Environment and Transport on the nomination of the Lord Chancellor), beginning at 10 a.m. on Tuesday 2nd June 1987, at the Assembly Rooms, Macclesfield Town Hall, Macclesfield, to hear representations from statutory objectors (as defined in the Highways (Inquiries Procedure) Rules 1976, so far as concerns the draft Orders specified at A to C, below and the Compulsory Purchase by Ministers (Inquiries Procedure) Rules 1967, so far as concerns the draft Order specified at D below) and, at his discretion, to hear representations from any other persons who may desire to appear and be heard.

The Orders which have been prepared in draft by the Secretary of State for Transport under the above mentioned Acts are:

- A. A523 Derby-Macclesfield-South of Stockport Trunk Road (Macclesfield Relief Road) No. 2 Order 198, notice of which was published on 20th November 1986. This is an Order under sections 10, 12 and 41 of the Highways Act 1980 which, if made, will provide that a new highway about 2.61 kilometres in length which the Secretary of State for Transport proposes to construct between the junction of Brocklehurst Way and Hulley Road, Macclesfield, and a point on the A523 80 metres north west of its junction with Flash Lane, Prestbury, shall become a trunk road.
- B. The A523 Derby-Macclesfield-South of Stockport Trunk Road (Macclesfield Relief Road) (Detrunking) Order 198, notice of which was published on 20th November 1986. This is an Order under sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980 which, if made, would transfer responsibility for the 5 kilometre section of the existing A523 between a point 50 metres north of its junction with Windmill Street, Macclesfield, to a point 80 metres north of its junction with Flash Lane, Prestbury, from the Department of Transport to Cheshire County Council.
- C. The A523 Derby-Macclesfield-South of Stockport Trunk Road (Macclesfield Relief Road) (Side Roads) Order 198, notice of which was published on 20th November 1980 which, if made, will authorise the Secretary of State for Transport:
  - (a) to carry out the improvement of highways;
  - (b) to stop up highways;
  - (c) to construct new highways;
  - (d) to stop up private means of access to premises; and
  - (e) to provide new means of access to premises;
 all at Macclesfield, Bollington and Prestbury in the District of Macclesfield, in the County of Cheshire.
- D. The Compulsory Purchase Order (No. NW ) 198, A523 Derby-Macclesfield-South of Stockport Trunk Road,
