The Borough of Trafford (Lostock Road, Urmston) (Restriction of Use of Cycle Track)

Notice is hereby given that the Trafford Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Borough of Trafford (Sixth Street and Tenth Street, Trafford Park Village) (Revocation of Street Playgrounds) Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that on 6th April 1987 the Trafford Borough Council made the above-named Order under sections 1 and 2, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order is to revoke the Street Playgrounds Order on the following lengths of highway:

Sixth Street, from its full length from First Avenue to Third Avenue.

Tenth Street, from First Avenue to Second Avenue.

The Borough of Stretford (Street Playgrounds) Order 1947 insofar as it relates to Sixth Street and that part of Tenth Street, from First Avenue to Second Avenue, is revoked.

The Borough of Trafford (New Street, Cedar Avenue, Altrincham) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order

Notice is hereby given that the Trafford Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday as follows:

New Street, west side, from a point of 15 metres south of Cedar Avenue to a point 15 metres north of Cedar Avenue.

Cedar Avenue, both sides, from its junction with New Street for a distance of 15 metres in an easterly direction.

Exemptions from the Order will include in respect of the loading and unloading of goods, the supply of gas, water and electricity, building or demolition operations, the setting down and picking up of passengers and disabled drivers' vehicles.

WILTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Wiltshire (Blue Boar Row, Salisbury) (Bus Stop) (Clearway) Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that the Wiltshire County Council proposes to make an Order under sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles, other than buses, from waiting in Blue Boar Row, Salisbury (north side) from a point 32 metres east of its junction with Endless Street.

While the Order remains in force it enables the Council at any time to lay or to remove the authorised markings at or from any bus stop in Blue Boar Row or adjust the position in that road of the authorised markings as traffic conditions may require.

Other vehicles will be permitted to wait at bus stops with authorised markings where necessary.

- (a) for the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (b) in certain circumstances in exercise of statutory powers;
- (c) in certain emergencies; and
- (d) for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

A copy of the draft Order and plan and statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the County Secretary & Solicitor's Office (Environment Section), County Hall, Trowbridge, and at the offices of the Chief Executive, Salisbury District Council, Bourne Hill, Salisbury, during normal office hours.
