## LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1976

*Southern Water Authority*  
*Romney Marsh Level Internal Drainage District*  
*Level of New Romney Internal Drainage District*  
*Denge and Southbrooks Internal Drainage District*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 11(4) and 109(6) of the Land Drainage Act 1976, has now confirmed the Southern Water Authority (Romney Marsh Levels Internal Drainage District) Order 1987 (S.I. 1987/555) confirming the Scheme submitted to him under section 11(1) of the Land Drainage Act 1976, making provision for:

- (a) the abolition of the Romney Marsh Level Internal Drainage Board and the Level of New Romney Internal Drainage Board;
- (b) the amalgamation of the internal drainage districts under the jurisdiction of the above-mentioned internal drainage boards into one new internal drainage district;
- (c) the construction of a new internal drainage board for the internal drainage district formed by such amalgamation;
- (d) the alteration of the boundaries of the new internal drainage district and of the Denge and Southbrooks Internal Drainage district of a portion of the new internal drainage district; and
- (e) matters supplemental thereto or consequential thereon.

The transferred area at (d) above comprises land in the Parish of New Romney in the District of Shepway in the County of Kent.

The Scheme may affect the liability to drainage rates of properties in the above-mentioned internal drainage districts.

A copy of the Order may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of the Southern Water Authority, Guildbourne House, Chatsworth Road, Worthing, West Sussex BN11 1LD, and at the offices of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, Room 405c, Great Westminster House, Horseferry Road, London SW1P 2AE.

By paragraphs 10, 11 and 12 of Schedule 3 to the Land Drainage Act 1976, it is provided that if any person aggrieved by an Order desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with he may, within 6 weeks after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court, and if any such application is duly made, the court, if satisfied that the Order is not within the powers of the Act or that the interests of the applicant has been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.
