The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 to authorise the stopping up of the highway described in the Schedule to this Notice to enable development, for which planning permission has been granted, to be carried out.

Stopping-up of Highways at Manchester City Centre
