**ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS
BLACKPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL**

*The Borough of Blackpool (Various Roads)
(Various Restrictions) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that on 16th April 1987 Blackpool Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Section 1(1)

and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers made the above Order.

The Order will have the following effect:

(1) Waiting will be prohibited at any time on the following lengths of the road:

Bond Street, west side, for a distance of 9 metres south of Withnell Road.

Crystal Road, south side, for a distance of 5 metres east and west of side street adjacent to No. 43.

Kay Street, east side, for a distance of 9 metres north of Bethesda Road.

Moor Park Avenue, both sides, for a distance of 9 metres east and west of access road to Grasmere Press premises.

Wilkinson Avenue, both sides, for a distance of 9 metres west of West Park Drive.

Withnell Road, south side, for a distance of 5 metres west of Bond Street.

Woodland Grove, north side, for a distance of 9 metres west of West Park Drive.

Whitegate Drive, east side, from property No. 64 for a distance of 50 metres in a southerly direction.

Back Warley Road, both sides, between Devonshire Road and Courtfield Avenue.

(2) Waiting will be prohibited between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive on the following length of road:

Queen Street, north side, for a distance of 9 metres east of The Strand.

(3) No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed upon:

That part of Highfield Road east between the junction of Dockypool Lane and a point 5 metres west of that junction.

(4) No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along the undermentioned length of road other than for the purpose of gaining access to the road:

Derwent Place, between junction of Fleetwood Road and a point 7 metres east of that junction. North and south junctions.

(5) No person shall cause any heavy goods vehicle the weight of which, whether laden or unladen, exceeds 7.5 tonnes to proceed on the following lengths of road:

All roads within the central railway land car coach park.

A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 1st May 1987, and a map showing the roads affected may be inspected during normal office hours at the address below.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from the date of this notice apply to the High Court for this purpose.
