Pursuant to section 139(6) of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 thereto, the Commissioners of Customs and Excise hereby give notice that by virtue of the powers contained in the customs and excise Acts, certain goods, namely, a red Dodge Van, registration number WAP 699S, heavy oil which had been taken as fuel into the said road vehicle which was found parked on the side of the roadway at Albany Industrial Park, Frimley, Surrey, and detained by a Customs officer of the Southampton Road Fuel Testing Unit on 22nd September 1986 and heavy oil an assortment of hand tools and gear which had been found on the said vehicle and detained on 22nd September 1986, have been seized as liable to forfeiture by force of the following provision(s) namely:

Section 13(b) of the Hydrocarbon Oil Duties Act 1979: that said goods being heavy oil on whose delivery for home use rebate has been allowed have been taken as fuel into a road vehicle namely a Red Dodge Van registration number WAP 699S as mentioned in section 12(2) of the above Act on or about 22nd September 1986 at Frimley and elsewhere in England and Wales.

Section 141(1)(a) of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979: The said road vehicle, red Dodge Van, registration WAP 699S, on or about 22nd September 1986 was used for the deposit of the heavy oil so liable to for forfeiture as aforesaid.

Section 141(1)(b) of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979: Heavy oil on whose delivery for home use rebate has been allowed in a 25 litre can an assortment of hand tools and other gear found in the said vehicle Red Dodge Van registration number WAP 699S with the heavy oil so liable to forfeiture as aforesaid.

If you claim that the said goods are not liable to forfeiture you must within one month from this date of this notice of seizure give notice of your claim in writing in accordance with paragraphs 3 and 4 of Schedule 3 to the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979.

If you are outside the United Kingdom and the Isle of Man you must also give the name and address of a Solicitor in the United Kingdom who is authorised to accept service of process and act on your behalf.
