SELBY DISTRICT COUNCIL

Selby (No. 3) Smoke Control Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that the District Council of Selby, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the abovementioned Act, as amended by section 1 and Schedule 2 of the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980, proposed, on 23rd April 1987 to make an Order entitled Selby (No. 3) Smoke Control Order 1987 declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11(4) of the Clean Air Act 1956, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shallbe guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Subject to the provisions of section 9 of the Clean Air Act 1968, any person who acquires for use in a smoke control area any solid fuel other than an authorised fuel shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100.

If made, the Order will come into operation on 1st September 1988, or at a later date determined by Selby District Council.

Copies of the draft Order and the map referred to therein may be inspected, free of charge, at the Civic Centre, Portholme Road, Selby, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from 8th May 1987 to 19th June 1987 inclusive.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to Chief Executive and Clerk of the Council, Selby District Council, Civic Centre, Portholme Road, Selby YO8 0SB, object to the making of the Order.

Description of Area

That part of the District of Selby comprising the Northern parts of Selby Town, part of Selby Common including Thorpe Wood area bounded to the south by Selby Dam from the bridge on Dam Lane to a point in the centre of the River Ouse opposite the outfall of Selby Dam. The area boundary follows the centre line of the river in a north-easterly direction to a point opposite the boundary line of the Selby North Ward. The boundary then turns north and follows the Selby North Ward boundary to its intersection with the boundary of Campey Mill. It follows the eastern and northern boundaries of Campey Mill to the point where the said Mill boundary rejoins the Selby North Ward boundary. The Smoke Control Order boundary them follows the Selby North Ward boundary to a point where the path from Wistow Road meets Black Fen Drain. The boundary follows the said path from Black Fen Drain to its junction with Wistow Road it then turns south along Wistow Road to the junction with Sherburn Road and turns west along Sherburn Road to its junction with Second Common Lane, it turns south down Second Common Lane to the junction of Flaxley Road and Greenlands Lane. At this junction the boundary turns south-west along
