METROPOLITAN BOROUGH OF KNOWSLEY

The Council of the Borough of Knowsley (Various Roads, Prescott) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Knowsley in exercise of its powers propose to make an Order under section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

When this Order comes into effect no persons will be allowed to cause or permit any vehicle to:

- (a) wait at any time in the following lengths of road:
 - (i) Stanley Crescent, Prescott, on its north-westerly side, from its junction with Park Road extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 13.7 metres; and
 - (ii) Park Road, Prescott, on its westerly side, from its junction with Stanley Crescent extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 13.7 metres;
- (b) wait between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday to Friday in the following length of road:
 - (i) Stanley Crescent, Prescott, on its north-westerly side, extending from a point 13.7 metres north of its junction with Derby Street to a point 13.7 metres west of its junction with Park Road.

Exemptions will allow waiting:

- (a) to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle;
- (b) by a disabled person's vehicle displaying a Disabled Person's Badge;

- (c) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from a vehicle; and in connection with:
- (d) Statutory Powers and Duties;
- (e) collection and delivery of postal packets; and, where necessary
- (f) the maintenance of the roads and services therein;
- (g) building operations; and
- (h) supplying Gas, Electricity and Water.

Full details of the proposals are in the draft Order which together with a map showing the prohibited area and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the receptions at the Municipal Buildings, Kirkby, Municipal Buildings, Huyton, Council Offices, High street, Prescott and Council Offices, Delph Lane, Whiston, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday to Friday.

The Leicester Traffic Regulation (Amendment) (No.) (Stanfell Road) Order 1987
