

SOUTHEND BOROUGH COUNCIL

Borough of Southend-on-Sea (Greyhound Way and Stadium Road) Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting Order 198

Notice is hereby given that the Southend-on-Sea Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act the effect of which will be as follows:

- (i) to prohibit and restrict waiting in Greyhound Way and Stadium Road as follows:

Greyhound Way, from the west kerblines of Sutton Road westwards for a distance of 60 metres, both sides, 24 hours daily.

Greyhound Way, from the east kerblines of Stadium Road eastwards for a distance of 32 metres, south side, 24 hours daily.

Stadium Road, from the south kerblines of Redstock Road southwards for a distance of 15 metres, west side, 24 hours daily.

Greyhound Way, from a point 60 metres west of the west kerblines of Sutton Road westwards to a point 18 metres east of the east kerblines of Stanfield Road, north side, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday.

Greyhound Way, from a point 60 metres west of the west kerblines of Sutton Road westwards to a point 32 metres east of the east kerblines of Stadium Road, south side, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday.

- (ii) to revoke waiting restrictions in Stadium Road on the west side from a point 50 yards south of its junction with Redstock Road, southwards for a distance of 35 yards.

Borough of Southend-on-Sea (Various Roads) Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting (No.) Order 198

Notice is hereby given that the Southend-on-Sea Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3) and 4 (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act the effect of which will be to prohibit and restrict waiting in Albany Avenue, Cliff Avenue, North Road and Sweyne Avenue as follows:

Albany Avenue, from the west kerb-line of North Road westwards for a distance of 15 metres, both sides, 24 hours daily.

Cliff Avenue, from the west kerb-line of North Road westwards for a distance of 15 metres, both sides, 24 hours daily.

Sweyne Avenue, from the east kerb-line of North Road eastwards for a distance of 15 metres, both sides, 24 hours daily.

North Road, from a point 15 metres north of the north kerb-line of Sweyne Avenue to a point 15 metres south of the south kerb-line of Sweyne Avenue, east side, 24 hours daily.

North Road, from a point 15 metres north of the north kerb-line of Albany Avenue to a point 15 metres south of the south kerb-line of Albany Avenue, west side, 24 hours daily.

North Road, from a point 15 metres north of the north

kerb-line of Cliff Avenue to a point 15 metres south of the south kerb-line of Cliff Avenue, west side, 24 hours daily.

North Road, from a point 10 yards north of its junction with the vehicular access to the garages north of "Blackdown" flats to a point 15 metres south of the south kerb-line of Cliff Avenue, west side, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday.

North Road, from a point 15 metres north of the north kerb-line of Cliff Avenue to a point 15 metres south of the south kerb-line of Albany Avenue, west side, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday.

North Road, from a point 15 metres north of the north kerb-line of Albany Avenue to a point opposite the southern boundary of No. 27 North Road, west side, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday.
