- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading and unloading vehicles;
- (c) emergency service vehicles; (d) disabled persons' vehicles;

and where necessary in connection with:

(e) the maintenance of the road;

(f) supply of gas, electricity and water; (g) delivery and collection of postal packets.

Full details of the proposals are in the draft Order which, together with plans showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, may be examined during normal office hours at the Borough Secretary's Department at the address given below or at the Council's branch offices at Berkhamsted and Tring. The County of Dorset (Traffic Management) (Various Roads, Dorchester) Order 198

Notice is hereby given that the Dorset County Council propose (subject to the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport) to make an Order under sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3), 3 (2), 4 (2), 32 (1) and 124 (1) (d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to:

(a) prohibit all vehicles at all times, except for loading by heavy goods vehicles at properties fronting the streets between 5.30 p.m. and 10 a.m., except for licensed market traders and bullion vehicles on the following lengths of road:
(i) Cornhill for its entire length;

- (ii) South Street, between its junction with Cornhill and New Street;
- (iii) Durngate Street, between its junction with South Street and a point 13 metres east thereof.
- (b) prohibit all vehicles at all times, except for access to properties fronting the street and parking places for the disabled, on the following lengths of road:

 (i) New Street, for its entire length;

 (ii) South Street, between its junction with New Street and South Walks Road.

- (iii) Durngate Street, between a point 21 metres west of its junction with Church Street and a point 13 metres each of its junction with South Street.
- (c) prohibit waiting at any time on South Street, on its western side, between points 87 metres and 120 metres south of the southern side of New Street.
- (d) prohibit loading between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m., except for postal vehicles delivering and collecting postal packets, on South Street, on both sides, between points 11 metres and 24 metres south of the southern side of New Street.
