## WATER RESOURCES ACT

### NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that application is being made to the Wessex Water Authority, Bristol Avon Division, by M. H. Trippick for a licence to abstract water from the Spring at Blakes Farm, Oakhill, Bath (ST646467). The rates at which water is to be taken are 10 cubic metres (approx. 2,200 gallons) per day and 3,000 cubic metres (approx. 660,000 gallons) per annum. The water is to be used for bottling and sales.

A copy of the application and associated documents may be inspected, free of charge, at Blakes Farm, Oakhill, Bath, at all reasonable hours from 20th July 1987 to 17th August 1987 inclusive.

## ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

### BEDFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Bedfordshire (Bedford Street, Ampthill) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that on 17th July 1987 the County Council of Bedfordshire made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit as from 20th July 1987 the waiting of vehicles at all times on the east side of Bedford Street (B530), Ampthill, from a point approximately 79 metres north of the junction with Church Street in a northerly direction for a further distance of approximately 54 metres.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the lengths of road to which the Order relates may be examined during normal office hours at the offices of the undersigned at County Hall, Bedford.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 17th July 1987 make application for the purpose to the High Court.

1. *Name of parking place:* Bow Street Multi-Storey Car Park.

2. *Position in which vehicle may wait:* Wholly within a parking bay.

3. *Classes of vehicles:*

(i) Motor cars within the provisions of section 136(2)(9) of the said Act of 1984.

(ii) Motor cycles as defined in section 136(4) of the said Act of 1984.

(iii) Motor vehicles constructed or adapted for use for the conveyance of goods or burden the unladen weight of which does not exceed 1525 kg.

(iv) Invalid carriages.

(v) Disabled persons' vehicles.

4. *Days of operation of parking place:* Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.

5. *Hours of operation of parking place:*

Daytime 0800 to 2400 hours.

Night-time 2400 to 0800 hours.

6. *Maximum period for which vehicles may wait:* No limit within the hours of operation.

### DURHAM COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Durham (Byerley Road and Un-named North Access Road to Lambton Street, Shildon) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1987.*

Notice is hereby given that the Durham County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit the waiting by vehicles at any time on any day on the roads set out in the Schedule hereto.

The Order will contain exemptions in respect of boarding or alighting; loading and unloading of goods; building, industrial or demolition operations and the removal of obstructions to traffic; maintenance of the road; delivery or collection of postal packets; vehicles being used in pursuance of statutory powers; police, fire brigade, ambulance and disabled persons' vehicles being used in connection with weddings or funerals.
