THE TRUNK ROAD (A494) (ASTON HILL, CLWYD) (CLOSURE OF CENTRAL RESERVE CROSSING) ORDER 1987.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to close the gap in the central reserve opposite the junction of the trunk road with Aston Hill.

WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY ACT 1949

The Secretary of State gives notice pursuant to subsection 1(4) of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1949 ("the Act") to all those who are licensed under subsection 1(1) of the Act, of the variations appearing below to each of such licences which,

- (1) has been issued and remains in force;
- (2) permits the installation and use of Citizens' Band sending and receiving stations for Wireless Telegraphy; and
- (3) is known as Citizens' Band Radio Licence.

Each of such licences shall be varied from 1st September 1987 so as to read as follow:
