WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY ACT 1949

The Secretary of State gives notice, pursuant to section 1(4) of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1949 to those licensed under a Citizens' Band Radio Licence which has been issued and remains in force, of the following variation to the above named licence:

In Clause 2 of the licence the following words shall be substituted for sub-clause (b):

- (b) "use a CB Station for sending and receiving only:—
- (i) messages in plain speech;
 - (ii) signals of less than 2½ seconds in length which are intended to call up any other CB Station; and
 - (iii) signals of less than 1 second in length which are intended to identify a CB Station or to mark the end of a message sent by a CB Station."

The Trunk Road (A69) (West Road, Newcastle-upon-Tyne) (Prohibition of Use of Gaps in Central Reservation) Order 1987 (Variation) Order 1987

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) and (2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, in respect of the Carlisle-Sunderland Trunk Road (A69), at West Road in the City of Newcastle-upon-Tyne, in the County of Tyne and Wear.

The effect of the Order will be to vary the Trunk Road (A69) (West Road, Newcastle-upon-Tyne) (Prohibition of Use of Gaps in Central Reservation) Order 1987 so as to bring forward the date on which two gaps in the central reservation of West Road (one opposite the junction with Southway, and the other opposite the junction with Sandringham Road) will be closed, that is to say from such time as the proposed Newcastle Western Bypass and West Road Roundabout are open for through traffic, to 1st March 1988.
