CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

The City of York (No. 14) Smoke Control Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of York in exercise of the powers conferred on them section 11 of the above-mentioned Act, as amended by Schedule 2 of the Local Government Planning and Land Act 1980 propose to make an Order entitled "The City of York (No. 14) Smoke Control Order 1987", declaring an area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the proposed Order and by virtue of section 11(4) of the Act, if on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of the building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £400 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

The Order will not come into operation before 1st July 1988.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected, free of charge, at the Chief Executive and Town Clerk's Office, Guildhall, York at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from 5th November 1987.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the City Solicitor, Guildhall, York, object to the making of the Order.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the proposed Order and by virtue of section 11(4) of the Act, if on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of the building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £400 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

NORTH BEDFORDSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL

North Bedfordshire Borough Council (King Street, Kempston) (Doctors' Parking Place) Order 1987

Notice is hereby given, on 5th November 1987, the North Bedfordshire Borough Council, acting as agents for the Bedfordshire County Council, made an Order under section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to site a Doctors' parking place for the exclusive use of registered medical practitioners, operating from the surgery at 273 Bedford Road, Kempston on the east side of King Street from a point 25 metres from its junction with Bedford Road to a point 38 metres from the said junction.

A copy of the Order which will come into effect on 9th November 1987 and a map showing the parking place, may be examined either at the offices of the Clerk to Kempston Town Council, The Manor, Kempston or at the address below, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 5th November 1987, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
