NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971, SECTION 210

The City of Southampton (Napier Road) Footpath Diversion Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that on 1st June 1987 Southampton City Council confirmed the above-named Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order").

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the public rights of way forming two footpaths of approximately 18 metres in length to the south-west of numbers 2 to 28 Napier Road and numbers 30 to 56 Napier Road to a position approximately 6 metres from the diverted footpaths forming two footpaths running in a south-westerly direction for approximately 18 metres and then in a north-westerly direction for approximately 5 metres.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the plan contained in it has been deposited at my office at the Civic Centre, Southampton and may be inspected free of charge during normal office hours. Copies of the Order and plan may be purchased.

This Order becomes operative as from the date on which it is certified by Southampton City Council that the provisions of Article 2 of the Order have been complied with but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he may under section 244 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 within 6 weeks from 6th November 1987 make application for the purpose to the High Court.

The City of Southampton (Lydgate Road) Footpath Diversion Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that on 3rd June 1987 Southampton City Council confirmed the above named Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order").

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the public right of way between Lydgate Road and Bursledon Road for approximately 43 metres in length to the south-east of 162 to 182 Lydgate Road to a line adjacent to the diverted footpath for approximately 44 metres in length.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the plan contained in it has been deposited at my office at the Civic Centre, Southampton and may be inspected free of charge during normal office hours. Order and plan may be purchased.

This Order becomes operative as from 6th November 1987 but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he may under section 244 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 within 6 weeks from 6th November 1987 make application for the purpose to the High Court.

NOTICE OF GRANTING OF AUTHORISATION

OPENCAST COAL ACT 1958

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 1 of the Opencast Coal Act 1958, on 7th October 1987, granted to the British Coal Corporation the Gilfach Iago Authorisation 1987 to work coal by opencast operations or to cause or permit coal to be worked by such operations.

The aggregate of the land specified in the authorisation as land which the British Coal Corporation will require to occupy for the purpose of enabling operations to be carried out for, or incidental to, the fulfilment of the purposes:

- of working coal by opencast operations in pursuance of the authorisation, and
- of restoring land affected by the working of coal in pursuance of the authorisation or by operations connected therewith,

is the land described in the Schedule hereto.

A copy of the authorisation and of the map referred to therein have been deposited at Glyn Tai Opencast Site Offices, Saron, near Ammanford, Dyfed, and may be seen there at all reasonable hours.

The authorisation becomes operative on the date on which this notice is first published in a local newspaper, or the date on which it is first published in the *London Gazette*, whichever is the later date; but a person aggrieved by the authorisation may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks from the operative date, question its validity on the grounds:

- that authorisation is not empowered to be granted, or
- that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by failure to comply with any statutory requirement relating to the authorisation.
