*The Metropolitan Borough of Bury (Butterstile Lane, Prestwich)
(Prohibition of Waiting and Restriction of Loading or
Unloading) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Metropolitan Borough of Bury propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

No Waiting at Any Time

Butterstile Lane, Prestwich

East side, from a point 15 metres south of the southerly kerb-line of Sandy Lane for a distance of 20 metres in a southerly direction.

No Waiting at Any Time

No Loading 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Butterstile Lane, Prestwich

West side, from a point 31 metres south of the southerly kerb-line of Sandy Lane for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.

Exceptions will be included in order to permit waiting for boarding or alighting, loading or unloading, funerals, building operations or work on or under the length of road referred to in the paragraph above, except where specifically restricted. Disabled persons' vehicles bearing a disabled persons' badge and a parking disc will be allowed to wait for up to two hours, return prohibited within one hour in the length of road referred to in the paragraph above, except where specifically restricted.
