#### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

##### *The A423 West of Maidenhead to Oxford Trunk Road (Maidenhead Thicket-Burchetts Green, Berkshire Section Side Roads) Order 1987*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that, in relation to the above mentioned trunk road between Maidenhead Thicket and Burchetts Green in the County of Berkshire, he has made an Order under sections 12, 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980, the effect of which is:

- (a) to authorise him:
  - (i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways;
  - (ii) to stop up highways;
  - (iii) to construct new highways;
  - (iv) to stop up private means of access to premises; and
  - (v) to provide new means of access to premises, all between Maidenhead Thicket and Burchetts Green aforesaid; and
- (b) provide for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Berkshire as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.

#### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

##### *A423(M) Motorway (Maidenhead Thicket Section) and Connecting Roads Scheme 1987*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made a Scheme under sections 16, 17 and 19 of the Highways Act 1980, the effect of which is:

- (a) to authorise him:
  - (i) to provide for the exclusive use of traffic of Classes I and II of the classes of traffic set out in Schedule 4 to the Highways Act 1980 a special road about 370 metres in length extending from the north-western end of the existing A423(M) motorway where it joins the A4 Bath Road roundabout at Maidenhead Thicket in the County of Berkshire, to a point where it joins the proposed new route of the A423 trunk road; and
  - (ii) two special roads to connect the above-mentioned special road with a new roundabout to be constructed as part of the A4 Bath Road; and
- (b) to provide for the said special roads to become trunk roads on the date when the Scheme comes into force.
