The County Council of Clwyd (King Edward Street, Alexandra Street and Link Road, Shotton) (Prohibition of Waiting and One-Way Traffic) Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that on the 10th November 1987 the Clwyd County Council made the above-named Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is:

- 1. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the sides of lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice.
- 2. To prohibit any vehicile from proceeding in the road or lengths of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Notice in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road or length of road in column 2 of the said Schedule.

day).
