

*The Walsall Metropolitan Borough (Lodge Road, Walsall)
(Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order, 1987*

The Order will prohibit any motor vehicle from proceeding in Lodge Road, Walsall, from its junction with Park Road for a distance of 3 metres.

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Richmond-upon-Thames propose to make the above Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

The effect of the proposed Order will be to provide disabled drivers parking bays:

- (a) on the north-west side of Warwick Road, Twickenham outside No. 31;

CHARNWOOD BOROUGH COUNCIL

*Borough of Charnwood (Traffic Regulation) (Various locations,
Loughborough) Order 198*

Notice is hereby given that Charnwood Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Leicestershire in exercise of the powers of the County Council under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) and Part IV to Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to make an Order the effect of which will be:

1. To prohibit waiting at any time on

- (a) *Nottingham Road* North west side from its junction with Barrack Row in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 26 metres.
- (b) *Barrack Row* Entire length.
- (c) *Biggin Street* Both sides from its junction with the A6 in a northerly direction for a distance of 16 metres.
- (d) *Radmoor Road* North-west side from a point 7 metres south-west of its junction with Burleigh Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 26 metres.

2. To prohibit waiting between 0800 and 1800 Mondays to Saturdays on

(a) *Beeches Road*

South-east side from a point 3 metres south-west of its junction with King George Avenue in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 20 metres.

North-west side from a point 44 metres south-west of its junction with Windmill Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 32.5 metres.

(b) *Wharncliffe Road*

East side from a point 10 metres north of its junction with Selbourne Street in a southerly direction to a point 10 metres south of its junction with Selbourne Street.

(c) *Russell Street*

Both sides from a point 10 metres north-east of its junction with Selbourne Street in a south-westerly direction to a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Selbourne Street.

(d) *Selbourne Street*

South west side from its junction with Russell Street in a south easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres.

South-side from its junction with Wharncliffe Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 15 metres.

North-east side for its entire length.

(e) *Empress Road*

North-east side from a point 25 metres north-west of its junction with Little Moor Lane in a south-easterly direction to a point 14 metres north-west of its junction with Little Moor Lane.

North-east side from a point 14 metres north-west of its junction with Little Moor Lane in a south-easterly direction to its junction with Little Moor Lane.

North-east side from a point 20 metres south-east of its junction with Little Moor Lane in a north-westerly direction to its junction with Little Moor Lane.

(f) *Little Moor Lane*

Both sides from a point 20.5 metres south-west of its junction with Empress Road in a north-easterly direction to a point 13.5 metres south-west of its junction with Empress Road.

Both sides from a point 13.5 metres south-west of its junction with Empress Road in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Empress Road.

3. To Limit waiting for 30 minutes in any hour, between 0800 and 1800 on Mondays to Saturdays on

Biggin Street (West side) from a point 16 metres north of its junction with the A6 in a northerly direction for a distance of 11 metres.

The proposed Order contains certain exemptions to permit waiting in connection with funerals, building operations, work in connection with public services, boarding or alighting, loading or unloading, and for hackney carriage vehicles and vehicles parked by certain handicapped persons.

Existing traffic orders will be revoked or amended as necessary.

Full details of the proposals are in the draft Order which, together with maps showing the restricted areas and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the Enquiry Counter, Municipal Offices, Southfields, Loughborough on Mondays to Thursdays between 8.30 a.m. and 5 p.m. and on Fridays between 8.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. Any objections to the proposed Order should be sent together with the grounds for objection in writing to the undersigned by not later than 11th December 1987.
