*South Kesteven District Council (Off-Street Parking Places)  
(Stamford) Variation Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that on 11th December 1987 South Kesteven District Council proposes to make the above Order under section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The purpose of making the Order is to amend the South

Kesteven District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Stamford) Order 1987 by increasing the charges in some car parks. The new charging provisions are summarised below:

## ROCHDALE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

*Metropolitan Borough of Rochdale (Halifax Road, Wardle)  
(Prohibition of Waiting and Restriction of Loading/Unloading)  
(Borough) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that the Rochdale Borough Council in exercise of its powers under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to prohibit waiting at any time and prohibit loading/unloading between 7.30 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 6.30 p.m. on Monday to Friday inclusive on:

*(a) Halifax Road*

- (i) northerly side from its junction with Cooper Street to a point 120 metres east of its junction with Union Road;
- (ii) southerly side from a point 20 metres west of its junction with William Street to a point 75 metres east of its junction with Smithy Bridge Road.

*(b) Birch Road*

- (i) north-easterly side from its junction with Halifax Road to its junction with Edward Street;
- (ii) south-westerly side from its junction with Halifax Road for 20 metres in a north-westerly direction.

*(c) Smithy Bridge Road*, both sides from its junction with Halifax Road to its junction with Old Road.

*(d) Union Road*, both sides from its junction with Halifax Road for 14 metres in a northerly direction.

*(e) Total revocation of the Greater Manchester County (Halifax Road, Wardle and New Road/Smithy Bridge Road, Littleborough) (Prohibition of Waiting) (County) Order 1982.*

The proposed Order would contain certain exemptions relating to emergency vehicles and statutory undertakers, disabled persons, loading and unloading, persons boarding and alighting from vehicles.

A copy of this Order and a map showing the length of road concerned may be inspected at the Information Office, Municipal Offices, Smith Street, Rochdale between the hours of 9.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 4.45 p.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

Objections to the proposed Order stating the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 7th December 1987.
