MORECAMBE GAS FIELD DEVELOPMENT

Notice of Application for a Submarine Pipeline Works Authorisation

Hydrocarbons Great Britain Limited hereby gives notice on behalf of itself in accordance with the provisions of Part I of Schedule 4 to the Petroleum and Submarine Pipelines Act 1975 that it has made an application to the Secretary of State for Energy for the grant of authorisations for the construction and use of submarine pipelines for the Morecambe Gas field Development:

(a) Two 609.6 millimetres (24 inches) outside diameter infield gas pipelines for the conveyance of water saturated natural gas between production platforms DP6 and DP8 and the Central Processing Platform CPP1.

(b) Two 60.3 millimetres (2 3/8 inches) outside diameter infield glycol pipelines for the conveyance of monoethylene glycol between the Central Processing Platform CPP1 and the production platforms DP6 and DP8.

A map delineating the route of the proposed pipelines together with certain further information may be inspected at the places listed in the Schedule to this notice from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on each weekday from the date that this notice is published until the date mentioned in the next paragraph of this notice.

Pursuant to a direction of the Secretary of State, representations with respect to the applications may be made in writing and addressed to the Secretary of State for Energy at Thames House South, Millbank, London SW1P 4QJ not later than 14th December 1987 and should bear the reference PEP/68/606/138 and state the grounds upon which the representations are made.
