

## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the diversion of Valley Road, Newhaven in the county of East Sussex to enable development consisting of 132 dwelling houses and associated car-parking to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted by Lewes District Council under Part III of the said Act.

The proposed Order will require that the new length of highway to be provided as the diversion is to be a highway maintainable at the public expense for which the highway authority is to be the East Sussex County Council.
