(Robert Hall Street) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given, that Leicester City Council acting as agent for Leicestershire County Council proposes to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to:

- (1) Stop vehicles waiting at any time, except for permitted loading for a period of 20 minutes in:
 - (a) Beaumanor Road the east side between points 10 metres north and south of its junction with Robert Hall Street;
 - (b) Robert Hall Street (i) the north side between its junction with Beaumanor Road and a point 30 metres east; and (ii) the south side between its junction with Beaumanor Road and a point 5 metres east.
- (2) Stop vehicles waiting between 0800 to 1830 Monday to Friday except for permitted loading for a period of 20 minutes in Robert Hall Street:
 - (a) the north side between a point 30 metres east of its junction with Beaumanor Road and its eastern extremity; and
