(Welwyn Garden City Town Centre)
Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting (Variation) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that the Welwyn Hatfield District Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act, 1972 with the Hertfordshire County Council have made an Order under section 1(1) and (2), 2(1), to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order which comes into force on 20th November 1987 will be to permit only Hackney Carriages to wait in the lay-by in Church Road, Welwyn Garden City which is situated 89 metres south-east from the junction with Parkway for a distance of 24 metres.

A copy of the Order and plan showing the length of road affected may be inspected during normal office hours at the Council Offices, The Campus, Welwyn Garden City and at the Council Offices, 16 St. Albans Road East, Hatfield, Herts.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks of the date of this notice make application for the purpose to the High Court.

OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*Oxfordshire County Council (A422, Banbury)
(Derestriction) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that on 11th November 1987, the Oxfordshire County Council with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport, made the above Order under section 82 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, the effect of which is to derestrict that length of the A422 known as the Banbury East-West Link Road, which extends from a point 41 metres east of the point where it joins the A423 Southam Road Roundabout to a point 15 metres west of its junction with the A361 Daventry Road, a distance of approximately 1,175 metres. The national speed limit appropriate to the road (60 m.p.h.) will now apply.

The Order will become operative on 20th November 1987.

A copy of the Order, together with the relevant map, are available for public inspection at County Hall, New Road, Oxford, between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 12.45 p.m. and 2.15 p.m. and 4 p.m. every weekday except Saturday.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Act Regulation Act, 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks of 20th November 1987, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

*(Un-Named Lane Connecting Principal Route A. 469 to
School Street, Tirphil) (Revocation and One-Way Traffic)
Order, 1987*

Notice is hereby given that the Mid Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 the effect of which will be:

- (i) to revoke "The Gelligaer Urban District Council (Traffic Regulation) (No. 1) Order, 1963".
- (ii) to prohibit the driving of vehicles in the length of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Notice in a direction other than that specified in Column 2.

An exemption will be provided in the Order to enable a mechanical road cleansing vehicle to operate during certain hours.

(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given, that the Lancashire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles, at any time on any day in any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.
