

The amount which a local authority borrows within its annual quota will bear interest at the appropriate rate in the quota set of rates. Authorities may borrow further sums at quota rates at the discretion of the Public Works Loan Commissioners. Other borrowing beyond the quota entitlement will be at the appropriate rate in the non-quota set of rates.

My Lords concur.

The Treasury determine the rates of interest accordingly.

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 to authorise the stopping up of the highway described in the Schedule to this Notice to enable development to be carried out.

The Order requires the provision of a new road, which shall be a highway maintainable at the public expense, and for which Gwynedd County Council shall be the Highway Authority.

Copies of the Order may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours at the Office of Arfon Borough Council, Technical and Planning Departments, Cwellyn, Llanberis Road, Caernarfon.

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds:

(a) that is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971' or

(b) that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of that Act;

he may within 6 weeks of 20th November 1987 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

The highway to be stopped up is at Caernarfon in the county of Gwynedd and is that length of highway known as Wesley Street which extends from its junction with Chapel Street to its terminal point at the rear of Pool Street, a distance of 61 metres.

The Trunk Road (A55) (Holywell, Clwyd) (De-Restriction) Order 1987
