NATURAL MINERAL WATERS REGULATIONS 1985

Notice is hereby given that, in response to an application from Sohat High Spring, Falougha, Lebanon, the Minister of Agriculture Fisheries and Food has granted recognition to the water originating at Sohat High Spring, in accordance with the provision of Schedule 1 Part II of the Natural Mineral Waters Regulation 1985.

The Minister has granted recognition on the grounds that the Lebanese Ministry of Health and Social Affairs has certified that it is satisfied as to the matters set out in paragraph 2 of Schedule 1, Part I of the Regulations and that regular checks will be made on the maters specified in Schedule 2 of the Regulations.

This recognition is also subject to the understanding that the

Lebanese Ministry of Health will continue to be able to carry out the regular checks at the point of exploitation of the source and that if this should cease to be possible, the Sohat management will immediately cease export of the water to the United Kingdom. The recognition of the water took effect from 5th November

1987.
