NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MAKE A TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

The London Borough of Southwark (Restriction of Waiting on Bus Stops) (No.) Traffic Order 1987.

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with The London Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) Regulations 1986, that the Council of the London Borough of Southwark proposes to make the above-mentioned order.

The proposed Order would be made under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by Schedule V Part 1 Paragraph 4 (3) (a) of the Local Government Act 1985.

The general effect of the proposed Order would be to impose waiting restrictions by vehicles between 7 a.m. and midnight throughout the week in:

- (a) Galleywall Road, the north-east side, from a point 18.29 metres north-west of the northern kerb-line of Rotherhithe New Road north-westwards for a distance of 27 metres; and
- (b) Spurling Road, the south-west side, from a point opposite the north-western boundary wall of No. 1 Spurling Road north-westwards for a distance of 20 metres.

Nothing in the Order would apply in relation:

- (i) to any vehicle being used to provide a London bus service waiting at a place where it is authorised or required to pick up or set down passengers; or
- (ii) to a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency; or
- (iii) to any vehicle being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or the performance of such duties on that bus stop for the vehicle to wait on that bus stop; or
- (iv) to any vehicle being used in connection with any building operation, demolition or excavation on or adjacent to that bus stop, the removal of any obstruction to traffic on or adjacent to that bus stop, the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the road in which the bus stop is situated, the laying erection, alteration or repair on or adjacent to that bus stop of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunication system or the placing, maintenance or removal or any traffic sign, if the vehicle cannot conveniently and lawfully be used for that purpose in any part of the street which is not a bus stop or outside the prescribed hours; or

(v) to any vehicle waiting for a period not exceeding two minutes to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or load thereon or unload therefrom their personal

luggage:
Provided that if the said person is a person suffering from any disability or injury which seriously impairs their ability to walk or who is blind, the vehicle may be necessary to enable that wait for so long as may be necessary to enable that person to walk to, to board or alight from the vehicle or load thereon or unload therefrom their personal luggage.

(vi) in any case where the person in control of the vehicle is required by law to stop, or is obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident; or

(vii) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.

A copy of the proposed Order, and of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order together with plans can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the expiration of a period of 21 days from the date on which this Notice is published in the Municipal Offices, Larcom Street, SE17 1RY and the Town Hall, Peckham Road SE5 8UB.

NOTICE OF TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

The London Borough of Southwark (Free Parking Places) (Disbled Persons) (No. 2) Traffic Order 1987.

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Southwark on 20th November 1987 made the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by Schedule V Part 1 Paragraph 4(3) (a) of the Local Government Act 1985.

The general effect of the Order will be to:

- (a) designate disabled parking places in the Roads specified in the Schedule to this Notcie in which vehicles authorised by the Order may be left in any period during the permitted hours without charge;
- (b) provide that each parking place will operate between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive (Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays excepted);
- (c) specify, in respect of the parking places, that disabled persons' vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled person's badge (commonly referred to as the "Orange Badge") issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975 or 1982 may be left therein; and
- (d) provide that certain vehicles may wait in the parking places in certain circumstances, e.g. to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc.

A copy of the Order, which will come into operation for the purposes of the placing of traffic signs on 27th November 1987 and for all other purposes on 29th November 1987 and of the Southwark (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 1) Order 1984 (z) (and of the Orders which have previously amended or applied that Order) and of maps which indicate each learnth of road to which the Order place on he invested with length of road to which the Order relates can be inspected until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made on Mondays to Fridays during normal office hours at the Municipal Offices, Larcom Street, SE17 1RY and the Information Centre, Town Hall, Peckham Road SE5 8UB.

Copies of the Order may be obtained from the Municipal Offices, Larcom Street SE17 1RY.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
