

The effect of the Order which comes into force on 1st March 1988, is to vary the Trunk Road (A69) (West Road, Newcastle-upon-Tyne) (Prohibition of Use of Gaps in Central Reservation) Order 1987 so as to bring forward the date on which two gaps in the central reservation of West Road (one opposite the junction with Southway, and the other opposite the junction with Sandringham Road) will be closed. That is to say whereas the Order now varied effected closure of the gaps from such time as the proposed Newcastle Western Bypass and West Road Roundabout are open for through traffic, the variation Order now made effects such closure from 1st March 1988.

Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision contained in, the Order, on the ground that it is not within the powers with respect to the Order conferred by the above Act, or on the ground that any regulation made under, any provision of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of 25th November 1987, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
