*The County of Devon (Howell Road (Southern Link), Exeter)  
(Width Restriction) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that Devon County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

When the proposed Order comes into effect you will not be allowed to drive any vehicle more than 6 feet 6 inches in width (including any load) in Howell Road between its junction with Longbrook Terrace and its junction with Longbrook Street.

There are exemptions in the Order for vehicles being used for maintenance of the road, building operations or in the service of statutory undertakers.

*The County of Devon (A379 Dartmouth Road, Paignton)  
(30 m.p.h. Speed Restriction) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that Devon County Council propose to make an Order under sections 82(2) and 83(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

When the proposed Order comes into effect that length of Dartmouth Road (A379) at Paignton, which extends from a point 27 metres south of its junction with Clennon Rise to a point 50 metres south of its junction with Great Western Close (a distance of approximately 210 metres), will be subject to a speed limit of 30 miles per hour.

## MID GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

*(Cross Street, Clydach Vale) (Variation) and  
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1988*

Notice is hereby given that the Mid Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1, 2 and 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 the effect of which will be as follows:

(i) to delete item (iv) of the Schedule to the "Mid Glamorgan County Council (Cross Street and Clydach Road, Clydach Vale) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1987".

(ii) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at anytime on the eastern side of Cross Street, Clydach Vale, from the northern side of its junction with Clydach Road, northwards to the southern side of its junction with Brynhyfryd Street, a distance of approximately 90 metres (98 yards).

Exemptions will be provided in the Order to enable Medical Practitioners and Veterinary Surgeons to visit while "on call" and for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, building and road works, the maintenance, improvement, reconstruction, inspection or survey of the side of length of road, the maintenance of essential services, weddings, funerals and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office. Disabled person's vehicles displaying the relevant disabled person's badge will be allowed to wait for up to 2 hours with return prohibited within 1 hour.

A copy of the proposed Order, a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, and a map showing the side of length of road to which the proposed Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Rhondda Borough Council, Llewellyn Street, Pentre, Rhondda and at the Mid Glamorgan County Hall, Cathays Park, Cardiff during normal office hours.

## MID GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

*(Various Terraces, Llwynpia) (Prohibition of Entry)  
Order, 1988*
