*City of Stoke-on-Trent (Experimental Traffic Regulation)
(No. 16) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Stoke-on-Trent acting as agents for the County Council of Staffordshire propose to make an Order under section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) 4(2) 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to amend the waiting restrictions imposed on traffic in the central area of Hanley as specified in Schedule 1 to 4 and the Schedule of Revocations hereto.

Full details of this proposal are contained in a draft Order which, together with a map showing the roads concerned and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at my office during normal office hours. If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send your objections together with the grounds thereof in writing to me by 17th December 1987.

FIRST SCHEDULE

*No Waiting at any time
Sections of Street*

*Name of Street
Albion Street
(South side)*

- (i) from Lichfield Street to a point 18 metres east of the Town Hall access.
- (ii) from a point 5 metres east of the Town Hall access to a point 15 metres west of the Town Hall access including the Town Hall access to the depth of the footway to Albion Street.
- (iii) from a point 5 metres east to a point 5 metres west of Bagnall Street.
- (iv) from a point 5 metres east of the un-named access road on the southern side of Albion Street to a point 5 metres west of that access road.
- (v) from a point 5 metres east of Bethesda Street to Broad Street.

(North side)

The whole including both sides of the central reservation surrounding the War Memorial and separating the eastbound and westbound carriageways of Albion Street.

- (i) From a point 29 metres north of Potteries Way to a point 24 metres north of Ranelagh Street.
- (ii) from a point 10 metres south to a point 15 metres north of John Street.

from a point 29 metres north of Potteries Way to Albion Street.

*Birch Terrace
(South side)*

- (i) from Lichfield Street for a distance of 41 metres in an easterly direction.
- (ii) from a point 138 metres east of Lichfield Street to Charles Street.

(on the South side of Birch Terrace serving properties fronting Lichfield Street)*

*Broad Street
(Service road connecting St. James Street to Broad Street.*

- (ii) from a point 48 metres from Warner Street to a point 20 metres from Potteries Way.

(Eastern side)

(off Cannon Street)*

- (i) from Old Hall Street for a distance of 35 metres in a southerly direction.
- (ii) from a point 72 metres from Old Hall Street to Birch Terrace including the turning head and short cul-de-sac at eastern end of Birch Terrace.

- (i) from Old Hall Street for a distance of 111 metres in a southerly direction.
- (ii) from a point 143 metres from Old Hall Street to Birch Terrace.

*Cheapside
(Eastern side)*

- (i) from Piccadilly for a distance of 20 metres in a southerly direction.
- (ii) from Albion Street for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction.

Crown Street

- (i) from Old Hall Street for a distance of 20 metres in a southerly direction.
- (ii) from a point 35 metres south of Old Hall Street to its southern end.
